

At Eurwang-ri Beach, which is known for its white sand beach shaped like a crescent moon, you can see various water birds. The beach is rather large, with a length of about 700 m and average water depth of 1.5 m, and has a great landscape as there is a pine grove and strangely-shaped rocks and bizarre stones at both ends of the beach. It is also popular for a beautiful sunset and is suitable as a family resort

M Silmi Beach A clean sandy beach with black pines



Silmi Beach on Muuido Island has a clean sandy beach with black pines, and you can experience the sea and forest at the same time. It is connected with Silmido Island by a mud flat, and you can cross over for two hours a day when the tide is out. The distance from Silmi Beach to Silmido Island is about 100 m, and you don't have to wear special boots to cross it. If the sea route is open, the mud flat appears and you can have the unusual experience of gathering various marine creatures.

Seonnyeo Rock is located in a place packed with various strangely-shaped rocks and bizarre stones on the way to Eurwang-ri Beach. The scene of waves breaking against sharp rocks is magnificent. Many visitors come here to appreciate the red sunset that unfolds beyond the black rocks in the evening. The small dock behind Seonnyeo Rock along with the

Hanagae Beach, which is the largest mud flat in Muuido Island, is 1 km long and has fine particles of sand that is like flour. If you dig in the mud flat just a little, you can pick up surf clams with white flesh, conches and manila clams. As the beach faces west, the sunset here is reminiscent of a beautiful watercolor

HIKING & TREKKING

Horyonggoksan Mountain ^{"A mountaintop with a paulor of the construction of the constr}

Horyonggoksan Mountain, at an altitude of 245.6m above sea level, is the highest mountain on Muuido Island. Since a lot of unusual rock formations such as Madang Rock, Bucheo Rock, and vertical cliffs make up a magnificent view, it is called the Alps of the Yellow Sea along with Guksabong Peak in the center of the island. The name of the mountain originated from a legend about a battle between a tiger and a dragon, Anybody can easily climb the mountain because it is not very steep. Pine trees, Korean hornbeams, and oak trees make a thick forest, and rare plants such as lady's slipper grow there. You can climb it from Saemkkumi Quay, Keunmuri Quay, and Hanagae Beach, and once you get to the mountaintop you can

have a bird's-eve view of small neighboring islands such as Seungbongdo Island and Jawoldc Island and Incheon Int'l Airport. The sunset from here is another magnificent sight.

STUDY OF HISTORY

Yonggungsa Temple Incheon-si Tangible Cultural Heritage No. 15, a temple built by Great Master Wohyo during the reign of King Munmu of Silla



Yonggungsa Temple, located at the northeast foot of Baegunsan Mountain on Yeongjongdo Island, is said to have been built by Great Master Wohyo in the 10th year (670) of King Munmu of Silla. It was rebuilt by Heungseon Daewongun in the fifth year (1854) of King Cheoljong of Joseon, and the name was also changed to Yonggungsa. Yonggungsa Temple has such buildings as Gwaneumjeon, Yonghwanggak, Chilseonggak and Yosachae, and the recently built Maitreya Buddha with

a height of 11 meters. Gwaneumjeon is a gable-roofed building with a side surface shaped like the Chinese character "人," On a column there remain four writings (Juryeon) by Kim Gyu-jin (penname: Haegang). It is said that there was a Statue of Avalokitesvara carved from jade, but it was stolen during the Japanese occupation and currently a bronze statue is enshrined. Yosachae located at the entrance is also a gable-roofed building and the plaque on which Heungseon Daewongun wrote "Yonggungsa" is hung on the front of the building.

Tonggungsa Zelkova Tree (Incheon-si Monument No. 9): This gigantic tree, about 1,300 years old, with a height of 20 m and circumference of 5,63 m, is also called "grandpa tree" and "grandma tree." It has been cared for by people for a long time and is now protected by being designated as a monument because it has a high biological preservation value

Palmido Cruise Palmido Island, where Korea's first ighthouse is located

Palmido Island had been a military preservation district for a long time and civilian access was restricted, but it was opened to the public in 2009 after 106 years. On this island is the first lighthouse in Korea, built in 1903. This lighthouse signaled landing fleets during the Incheon Landing Operations of the Korean War It was designated as Incheon-si Cultural Heritage No. 40 on February 4, 2002.

House of Jo Byeong-su A traditional 130-year-old house designated as Incheon-si Cultural Heritage No. 16



This is the house of a middle-class family that was built in 1890 The house is composed of a gate building and main building, and has a broken "a" shape with some surfaces broken. The main building is 3 kan in front and 1.5 kan on the sides, and the main room and opposite room are on the left and right, respectively, with a main floored hall in the center. Next to the main room, a kitchen was installed, and part of its ceiling was lowered to make an attic that is used in the main room. Also,

the gate building has a reception room to the east and a 1-kan room and warehouse to the west with the main gate in the center. In front of the room there is a floored veranda. The house receives a steady stream of foreign visitors who want to experience a traditional Korean house.
