

After troops were stationed, public access to this place was prohibited for 50 years, therefore the natural ecosystem was preserved well. This location opened up to the public in 2001. **01 Chinatown**  
A place where Korean and Chinese cultures abide!  
Chinatown is, after the opening of the Incheon Port on 1883, a place where China's unique culture was formed as Chinese people lived together. When walking the streets between red signs and lanterns, you may feel like you are traveling in China. You can see Chinese culture and life by various sightseeing opportunities, such as Palou within Chinatown, Romance of the Three Kingdoms mural street, and Museum of Jajangmyeon.

**02 Open Port Culture District**  
A place where 140-year-long traces of history and cultural art breathe!  
This place was merely a quiet fishing village, but after the opening of a port in 1883, traditional companies from Japan and China advanced here, and each nation's foreign embassies were built. As a result, this place quickly became an international city. Also, as foreigner-reserved locations were selected, this place developed an exotic city atmosphere, and it became the gate of Incheon and grew as the greatest trading port. Now, many modern cultural heritages remain, so you can experience the history and culture of when the port was opened. Today, based on the unique city landscape that 140 years of history had made, diverse cultural facilities advanced to the Open Port Culture District, and it is becoming a magnificent location.

**03 Sampo International Market**  
A traditional market with a 100-year-old history!  
This market is Incheon's first modern permanent representative market with over 100 years of history along with the history of the opening of the port. In 1890, first fish market was established, and during the Japanese Occupation, it became state-built No. 1 'Everyday Goods Market' and the state-built No. 2 'Everyday Goods Market'. After the liberation, the Sampo-Traditional Market was formed, which is same as it is now. It is a place where Jajangmyeon and Dalgajangmyeon were invented rationally.
