01 Wolmi Park

The place that nature and history are alive

Place for rest, nature, and experiences!

As a military camp was stationed in this area and it had restricted access for 50 years, the natural ecosystem was well preserved. It was opened to the citizens in 2001. It has again been born as a new tourist attraction as Wolmsan Mountain that has been conserved as a dense forest, the observatory that you can have a glance at the coastal waters of Incheon on top of the mountain, and Korea Traditional Park that foreigners visit very much, and the Museum of Korea Emigration History that exhibits our nation's emigration history were created.

- 01 Korea Traditional Park**
Let's themed history, tradition, and be excited!
Korea Traditional Park recreated a palace garden, a Byeolsog Garden, and a private house garden. Byungniji Pond, Aeryongji Pond, Hwaeng, and Amisan Chimney were reproduced as the palace garden. Sowawoen Garden, Guldam Garden, and a habitat were done as Byeolsog Garden. Yangdang and traditional private houses were done as the private house garden. In addition, various ecological resources including a rice paddy field and a brook were also created.
- 02 Wolmi Culture Street**

As it operates the Traditional Culture Exhibition Hall, the Royal Culture Exhibition Hall, and the Planning Exhibition Hall, domestic and overseas tourists can watch, enjoy, and experience various kinds of Korean traditional culture.
- 03 Wolmi Observatory**

The 23m-high observatory located on top of Wolmi Park emits the colorful lights at night and reminds you of a spacecraft.

It was created to make vessels enter and leave Incheon Port all the time for 24 hours by overcoming the ebb and flow of maximum 10m as the first lock gate in Korea. When you visit the Exhibition Center for the Lock Gate in Incheon Port, you can enjoy various things to see and experience including the basic operation principle of the lock gate and the exhibition center.

02 The 1st International Ferry Terminal

The safe waterway from Incheon to China

When you try to go to China with a vessel, you have to the Incheon International Ferry Terminal. There are the 1st International Ferry Terminal in Yeonan Pier and the 2nd International Ferry Terminal in Hang-dong. They are equipped with duty free shops as well as the arrival halls and the immigration desk. You can go to Yinkou, Qinhuangdao, Yantai, Dalian, and Dangdeng.

03 Palmido Cruise Ships

Palmido, the first beautiful lighthouse island in Korea

Palmido has the first lighthouse in Korea. The Palmido Lighthouse that first turned up the light in Korea on June 1, 1903 has been preserved in that place being designated as the Incheon-designated Cultural Property Number 40 after performing its duty for the last 100 years. Now, the newly built lighthouse has turned up the light.

04 Incheon Complex Fish Market

The largest fishery products distribution market that you can move various marine products at affordable price!

This is the place that you must visit when you come to Yeonan Pier as it has provided fresh fishery products just caught by fishermen off the coastline of the West Coast. You can taste the marine products because sashimi is served by filling live fishes directly caught by restaurants. And you can enjoy various marine products at an affordable price as you like. Another fun thing to do is obtain additional services by bargaining with merchants over the price.

02 The Korea-U.S.A. Centennial monument

Symbol of Korea and Chinese exchange!

It was established in the site of Johnstone Villa, the landmark of Incheon in 1903 to commemorate the treaty of peace, commerce and navigation between Korea and the US and continue to develop the mutual trust and cooperation relationship between the two countries.


01 Chinatown

01 Chinatown

Visitors can enjoy the culture and lifestyle of China through various attractions such as Pai-loo, Sangmyul Mural Street, and Jangjomyeong Museum.

02 Cultural District of the Open Port

Treasure house of Korean modern culture

This place which had just been a fishing village was rapidly changed to the international city as trading companies from Western countries, Japan, and the Qing Dynasty entered and consulates from all countries of the world as soon as it was opened in 1883. And exotic cityscapes began to be created as settlements for foreigners only were set. And it grew as the gateway of the Joseon Dynasty and the first trade port. You can experience history and culture of the Age of Civilization as there are still a lot of modern cultural heritages. Today, the Cultural District of the Open Port has again and gradually been born as the attractive place as there have been various cultural facilities against the backdrop of the unique cityscapes created by history of more than 140 years.

01 Pai-loo

This building plays a role of the anchor of Chinese people!

It's the Chinese traditional gate that is red and put on red pillars. It means to drive away evil spirits and wish prosperity as the gate of the village erected at the mouth of the town by Chinese people. It is the representative symbol/icon of Incheon Chinatown that elaborate and beautiful architectural decorations are integrated with culture and art.

02 China Town Street

China Town, Small China in Korea!

You can meet overseas Chinese merchants wearing Chinese dresses, the Chinese traditional clothes. You can watch recently restored Chinese modern architecture and red signs and red lights that symbolizes China. You can taste Jangjomyeong, Gonggil Bread, and moon cakes.

03 Euseondang Shrine

The place that you can feel the breath of overseas Chinese!

Buddha, the Buddhist Goddess of Mercy, and Guan Yin or Guan Yin (an East Asian bodhisattva) were created as the Chinese temple with the meaning that people uphold justice and lead a life of virtue.

04 Korean-Chinese Rest Area

The place to relax that reproduced Chinese writers' garden style!

It's the outdoor cultural space utilizing garden styles of writers in Suzhou, China in the middle and late Qing Dynasty including a pavilion, a pond, containers, and the wall.

05 Qing and Japanese Concession area Boundary Stairs

This place has kept history of more than 140 years as it is!

This place directly shows Incheon's modern and contemporary history. The Qing Dynasty is located in the left and the Japanese Concession area is done in the right. You can check different architecture styles from each other with the boundary stairs as the center row.

06 Songwol-dong Donghwa (Fairy Tale) Village

05 Korean-Chinese Cultural Center and Overseas Chinese History Hall

Meet Chinese culture through overseas Chinese people's life!

It is located in China Town that history of Korea and China exists together. The Korean-Chinese Cultural Center has operated various performances for cultural exchange between Korea and China, the Chinese culture exhibition and Chinese cultural experience programs. The Overseas Chinese History Hall, the first overseas Chinese history hall in Korea, exhibits all kinds of relics that you can understand history and culture of overseas Chinese people who settled down in Chin Town in 1894.

06 Incheon Art Platform

Meet culture in warehouse of history!

Total 13 buildings including creative studios, ateliers, a library, the education department, an exhibition hall, and a performance center were created by remodeling the buildings in 1939 to 40 and the Age of Civilization with old Nippon Yusen Kaisha (NYK Line)/Registered Cultural Heritage No. 248. It was born by citizens and Incheon City's will to try to reuse history and places in the Age of Civilization culturally.

07 Incheon Open Port Museum (Old 1st Japanese Bank)

See the beginning of modern times!

It exhibits all kinds of modern civilization in the Age of Civilization including the first Seoul-Incheon Railway in Korea, the Maritime Customs, and the Incheon Mint Bureau by the 1st Japanese Bank.

08 Incheon Open Port Modern Architect (Old 18th Japanese Bank)

Modern history from the viewpoint of architecture!

It exhibits concession stairs when the port is opened and various modern buildings by utilizing the 18th Japanese Bank.
